## **Now that you brushed up on your turkey facts, please review these important reminders regarding your residence:**

- During times of absence such as Thanksgiving Break, remember to keep your thermostat at 60 degrees to keep pipes from freezing. A frozen pipe cannot only cause serious damage, but it can also be a *very* costly repair!
- Remove hoses from outside faucets. This is VERY IMPORTANT; otherwise, they will freeze back into the house.
- Once the snow starts falling ~~ here is a reminder to those of you with sidewalks: The City of Fort Collins requires the walks to be shoveled within 24 hours of a snowfall for safety reasons and is very strict on enforcing this requirement. Please insure that your sidewalks are promptly shoveled, unless the Homeowner's Association provides this service. If you are going to be out of town, be sure you make arrangements to have someone do your walks in the event of snow.
- If you are planning to be out-of town ~~ please make prior arrangements with your roommates or family members to deposit December rent on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> to avoid late fees.
